Swimming Training	3%	PE funding will be used pay for 10 members of staff to attend the STA Safety Award Training for Teachers. This means that the school can deliver high quality swimming lessons to each year group twice a week In the summer term, additional swimming lessons will be offered to all non- swimmers (with PPG children taking a priority)
PE equipment	4%	In September, some of the PE equipment needed updating- this included new football equipment, new tennis resources and a new set of hurdles.
Entrance into a inter school competitions	1%	As a school, we aim to provide opportunities for our children to represent the school in a number of sporting fixtures. Last year 181 pupils (75% of our pupils) competed in an inter-school event. The aim for this academic year is 80% of our pupils. Some events carry costs for entrance into the leagues, events and medals. In addition, a new kit was purchased
PE TA	92%	After achieving the Gold Award for the School Games Mark, the PE TA will help the school maintain a gold standard by the end of July 2024 As a school, we aim to offer all children the chance to take part in competitive sports. We will do this through house matches and inter school competitions. In addition, we continue to offer a wide range of extra- curricular clubs, before school, after school and at lunch time.
