Swimming Training	2%	PE funding will be used pay for 6 members of staff to attend the STA Safety Award Training for Teachers. This means that the school could deliver high quality swimming lessons to each year group twice a week In the summer term, additional swimming lessons will be offered to all non- swimmers (with PPG children taking a priority)
PE TA	92%	A specialist TA is employed at Westende. First and foremost, he provides additional support in all PE lessons The TA oversees the extra-curricular provision ensuring that a wide variety of clubs are offered. These include: football, netball, tag rugby, running, badminton and multi-sports. Competitive sporting opportunities are offered to all pupils. Across the year, children will participate in inter-school competitions in variety of sports such as football, netball, gymnastics, boccia and running. In addition, every children takes part in inter- house competitions in school in cross country, football, netball, football, swimming, rounders, and sports day. In addition, the sports TA tracks and monitors engagement in physical activity including extra-curricular clubs and external competitive opportunities Children at Westende engage with the School Games initiative and have achieved the Gold mark for the previous three years. The aim is to achieve the platinum award in the future
PE and playground equipment	6%	A new range of playground equipment was purchased back in September to allow 60 active minutes for all pupils. New PE equipment was purchased to ensure quality first teaching to happen across the school – this includes PE mats, netballs, dodgeballs, hockey equipment, basketballs and tennis balls.
PE CPD	0.5%	Staff CPD sessions will be delivered this academic year by specialist teachers in both swimming and dance.
